Jesus, Bread of Life

In a few days, a few weeks at most, we'll be into our fall routines. We'll leave the carefree days of summer behind and have little time for daydreams. Autumn brings us down to earth. As we move into this serious mode, we often revisit questions and projects that we've put aside. The summer break enables us to resume our daily responsibilities with renewed energy and interest. Problems that appeared to be insurmountable now have solutions. Impossible situations can be resolved. The same phenomenon happens when we listen to and read the Gospels. We may think that we have integrated Jesus' teachings and are well versed on many issues. But what if we were to approach Christ's words from a different perspective? We may not always be comfortable with the content. The current climate of indifference has perhaps made us less appreciative of Jesus' offer. Our convictions based on Gospel values are often ridiculed and contested by those who claim to be spiritually self-sufficient. Several lines from the Gospel according to St. John remind us of Jesus' words about the Eucharist, his identity and the magnitude of his gift. Jesus establishes perfect communication with those who have confidence in him. His gift of himself enables us to partake in a quality of life that supersedes anything that we could possibly imagine. We listen attentively and receive the Eucharist, the bread of life. We enter into a spiritual domain of unending possibilities that ultimately lead to eternal life. We drink the cup of salvation and commune with the divine Source of life. The people of Christ's era would have difficulty accepting his offer because any notion of sharing his body and blood would have been considered unclean and contrary to the Law. Jesus superseded this rule and revealed that he was sent by the Father, whose power he shared. Some of our contemporaries may feel that they can forego Christ's gift of the bread of life. Once we realize the possibilities, we won't deprive ourselves of eternal life by ignoring Christ's incredible offering!
