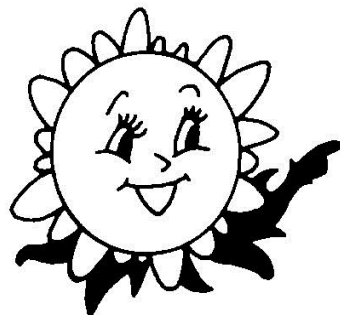

The tables are turned...

This is what happened to *this interrogator*, a lawyer, who attempted to trap Jesus. He reminds us of a movie scene in which an actor tries to ambush someone but instead finds himself ambushed. Jesus' response was not to answer the lawyer directly. Instead, he brought some perspective to an ancient law and *proposed* a revolutionary ethic to those who called themselves his disciples. Jesus referred to the Law as an expression of God's will for our happiness. Moses described the Law: *the word is very near to you; it is on your mouth and in your heart for you to observe*. Jesus knew his quotation from Deuteronomy. We should not be surprised to hear him *relate* the story of the *Good Samaritan* instead of merely responding with an answer. This story concludes unexpectedly with another question: "*Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?*" The question was: "*Who is my neighbor?*" Whom should I welcome as a brother or sister? What was the anticipated response? Instead Christ asked: "*How do I treat my neighbor?*" Clearly, Jesus situates the answer from the perspective of those actions *exhibit love* and not those whom we feel we *must love*. The implications are significant. A *neighbor* is one who acts and takes care of us. Jesus turned the tables on what was intended to be an embarrassing situation. He asked: "*Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?*" Which one knew *how to be a neighbor*? The response was evident and Jesus did not have to continue the conversation. The lawyer was stunned; he could have responded with "*The Samaritan, of course!*" Instead he understood the lesson and replied: "*The one who was a neighbor and showed him mercy.*" Jesus simply said to him: "*Go and do likewise.*" The lesson is simple but profound: "*Go and do likewise.*" Love should be truthful and active. *Do unto others...* This lesson teaches us to acknowledge what a Christian life entails and its end result: goodness. Whatever is contrary to this is only a caricature of faith and religion. *Do good, be good; learn how to be a good neighbor...* sums it up! It is essential to practice the Law, which both Moses and Christ followed.

It's up to us now to *ask* the questions and prepare to be questioned...
