No Church Without Us

Each baptized person is called to work for the harvest. It has taken a drastic reduction in the number of priests for the Church to recognize that lay people are part of its community and there is no Church without them. We are all called to proclaim the Kingdom of God.

The harvest is not entirely ours. Someone has sowed the seeds and brought them to maturity. The *vineyard* is our work environments, our families, our social connections and our community. Our task is not to water, weed, and care for the entire vineyard, but only the plot of earth that has been assigned to us. Its maintenance is our responsibility as vine growers. It is up to us to do our share and be rewarded with good grain, or in this case, good wine.

What is asked is not to list reasons why our Church is important. It is sufficient to be messengers of peace and bearers of hope in a world that has wealth and beauty, as well as its poverty and dark passages. As messengers we must never coerce, condemn or exclude people. Instead we respect each person's freedom and dignity. The success of our mission does not rest on one person's shoulders.

There aren't many workers to ensure a good harvest. In fact, few believers have the audacity to witness publicly to their attachment to Christ. We can be overwhelmed by the task that the Lord has given us; but we must not lose hope. Quite the contrary!

We will be recognized as missionaries by our adherence to Christ and not to a particular Church. It is important to recognize that the tasks are diversified and that many missionaries are needed to work for Christian unity. We are invited to transmit the Word to our families, in our places of work, and in the worlds of commerce, politics and culture.

It is important to adopt a peaceful attitude as we spread the Word: "*Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!'*". Christ reminds us that we are called to this mission because we are loved by God.
