MASS INTENTIONS

Mass intentions refer to the particular purpose for which a specific Mass is offered. This may be to honor God or thank him for blessings received. But technically a Mass intention means that the sacrifice is offered for some person(s) living or dead. The intention for which a priest offers a Mass is determined most often, by the intention of the donor of a Mass stipend, or by the priest's own devotion. An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

If you wish to reserve a specific date for a mass intention in 2014 or 2015 calendar year; please do so as soon as possible. Mass intention can be said for the living as well as for those who have passed away. The cost for a mass intention is \$15.00.

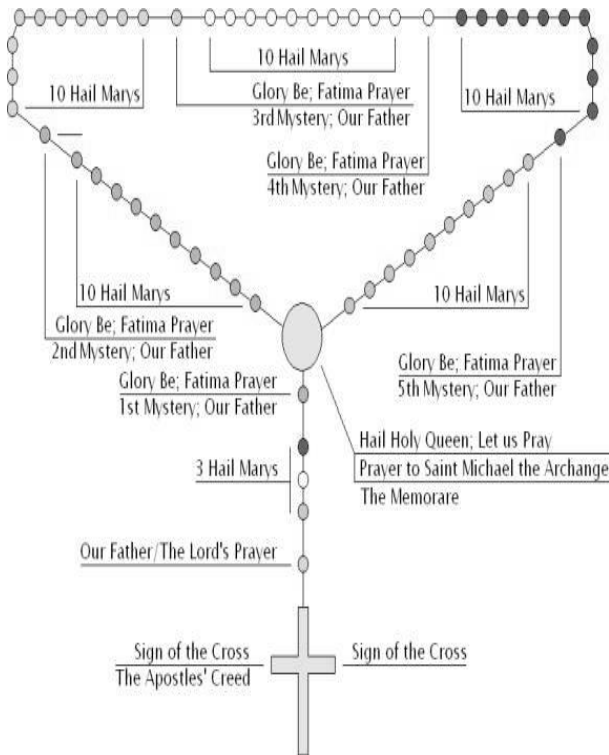

is traditionally the month of growth in regard to nature, and for this reason, May is one of my favorite months. It is extremely beautiful, but it is also important in the Church. May is also

traditionally the Month of Mary, where we recall the role of Mary in salvation.

She is the Virgin Mother of God, whose *fiat* allowed Our Lord to take human form. Because of her complete trust in God, she lived her life sinlessly. And after her life, she was assumed into Heaven by the power of God and crowned as Queen of Heaven and Earth. She is, of course, not divine. We worship only Jesus Christ, but we honor Mary as a saint. We honor God by remembering the role of Mary in the beginning of our salvation. And remember, Devotion to Mary always leads to Jesus Christ!

In May there are a number of wonderful feast days including the Anniversary of Fatima (May 13) and the Feast of the Queenship of Mary (May 31) according to the 1962 Calendar. According to the 1969 Calendar, May 31 is the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. I ask you to please say the Rosary each day, if possible, this month. **So, please pray the Rosary this month.**

Origine du mois de Marie

La dédicace d'un mois à une dévotion particulière est une forme de piété populaire. La dévotion du mois de Marie (mois de mai) est apparue à Rome au début du 18ème siècle. Elle s'est répandue d'abord en Italie sous l'influence des jésuites et est arrivée en France à la fin du 18ème siècle. Elle a été approuvée par le pape Pie VII au début du 19ème (21 novembre 1815) après avoir subi l'opposition des jansénistes.
