2 – Explanation of the goal to increase the monthly benefit with the rationale

Due to your generosity, we were able to increase the monthly pension from \$750 to \$800 effective July 1 of this year. Our goal is to increase the amount to \$1,100 in order to meet monthly living expenses. Considering the current cost of rent, cable, telephone, internet, food, automobile expenses, clothing, entertainment and some amount for miscellaneous, we require about \$2,100 monthly. CPP and OAS provide approximately \$1,000 monthly. This gives us the \$1100 we have set for our pension goal. We will work gradually to reach this level. 2 – Explication du but d'accroître le bénéfice mensuel ainsi que sa logique

Grâce à votre générosité, nous avons pu augmenter la rente mensuelle de 750\$ à 800\$ effectif le 1er juillet 2014. Notre but est d'augmenter ce montant jusqu'à 1 100\$ par mois afin de pourvoir aux dépenses du coût de la vie. Un examen du coût actuel du loyer, câble, téléphone, internet, nourriture, dépenses d'automobile, linge et loisirs, ainsi qu'un montant pour frais divers indique qu'il nous faudrait environ 2 100\$ par mois. Le fonds de pension du Canada et la pension de sécurité de la vieillesse donnent approximativement 1 000\$ par mois. C'est de là que nous établissons le 1 100\$ comme but de notre pension.
