### ***Faire la volonté de Dieu?***

*Lequel des deux a fait la volonté du père?* C'est la question que Jésus pose aux chefs des prêtres et aux responsables de la communauté (les Anciens), Après leur avoir raconté la parabole du père qui demande à ses deux fils d'aller travailler à sa vigne. L'un dit oui, mais n'y va pas, tandis que l'autre, après avoir dit non, se ravise et va y travailler. Évidemment que c'est ce dernier qui a fait la volonté du père. Jésus se sert de cette parabole pour inviter ses auditeurs à une démarche de conversion, comme savent si bien le faire les pécheurs et les prostituées : croire en Dieu, c'est se tourner sans cesse vers lui, c'est s'ajuster à sa volonté, c'est agir juste. Est-ce que cela nous concerne? Je pense que oui, car nous nous comportons assez souvent comme le fils qui commence par dire non pour ensuite faire (obéir) ce que le père lui demande. Mais quelle est donc la volonté de Dieu et que signifie faire sa volonté? La volonté de Dieu est synonyme pour l'essentiel de son plan de salut qu'il révèle à l'humanité à travers l'histoire de son peuple, et de façon achevée à travers la vie, l'agir et l'enseignement de Jésus. Jésus est la Bonne Nouvelle de la volonté de Dieu de donner aux êtres humains d'entrer dans une communion de vie et d'amour avec Lui. Jésus se nourrit de cette volonté quand il voit les Samaritains venir à lui dans une démarche de conversion. La volonté de Dieu que Jésus vient accomplir, c'est de ne perdre aucun de ceux que le Père attire à lui. C'est cette volonté de salut, de communion avec Dieu, que Jésus nous fait désirer quand il nous enseigne à prier : *Notre Père, ... Que ta volonté soit faite sur terre comme au ciel.* Ainsi donc, on comprend un peu mieux que faire la volonté de Dieu consiste à observer comment Jésus lui-même accomplit la volonté du Père pour ensuite vouloir nous-mêmes vivre comme des filles et des fils de Dieu, en obéissant au double commandement de Dieu et du prochain.

### ***Fulfilling God's will?***

*Which of the two did the will of his father?* Jesus asked the chief priests and community leaders this question after he told them the parable of the father and his two sons. One son had agreed immediately, but he didn't follow through. While the other first refused, he later thought about it and went to work in the vineyard. Obviously it was the latter who obeyed his father.

Jesus used this parable to invite his listeners to embark on a pathway of conversion, just as the sinners and prostitutes had done. Believing in God means that we look to God for direction, change our lives to fulfill his will, and act justly. How does this relate to us? We often perform like the son who initially said no to his father but then finally obeyed him. How can we know God's will? How can we fulfill it?

God's will is synonymous with his plan for our salvation, revealed to us through the history of his people and Jesus' actions and teachings. Jesus fulfilled God's will and people like the Samaritans were converted. When Jesus taught us to pray, he said: *Our Father ... thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.* We fulfill Our Father's will when we imitate Christ's life, strive to live as God's sons and daughters, and obey the two great commandments.
