My friend Ken, who is a librarian, had an enquiry regarding the lines inscribed on the base of the Statue Of Liberty. He later drew my attention to the welcome which the New World set out to give to those seeking to escape the Old World:

*Give me your tired, your poor,
Your huddled masses yearning to be free;
The wretched refuse of your teeming shore,
Send these, the homeless, tempest-tossed, to me;
I lift my Lamp beside the golden door!*

These lines are from a sonnet by Emma Lazarus who died in 1887 before she was 40 years old, but whose immortal lines on the Statue Of Liberty are engraved for all to see.
