Perfect Communication

God is love, said St. John, and, we add, perfect communication. The Trinity: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit exist in an eternal communion of love. These three persons in one may be explained as a magnificent family in which love constitutes the air that they breathe. *God is love*. Our God is a God of relationships, of internal and eternal communications.

God is not only love within the Trinity. This love is communicated through creation and particularly to human beings. God showed this love not only through the gift of Jesus Christ to humanity, but also through the Good News, the Church and sacraments, through the people whom we meet in life, and the opportunities that we are given to be part of God's great plan of salvation. This communicative aspect of love is important. We know that when we love someone, we talk about our experience. Other people notice its effect. Love is not self-centered. It gives generously of itself to others and it seeks opportunities to share joy with others. This is a very brief explanation of our God of love.

Let us celebrate the feast of the Trinity by praising God who is present in our lives and who wishes to share a relationship with us. Remember that God loves us intensely and infinitely as we make it our mission to return this love and share it with others.
