Does Money Guarantee Freedom?

Money appears to be a primary concern in our consumer-driven society. In the good old days, some people had their money under their mattresses: today we invest. Many people save their money while others spend every cent and fall into debt. But whether we save or spend it, money plays a significant role in our lives. To be *someone* today, we often feel we have to spend to impress others, to be seen as successful and possess the latest gadgets. Taken to extremes, this mindset enslaves us when money becomes the sole criterion of whether we excel in our political, social and personal lives.

A wise person prefers wisdom to money. Wisdom is valued more than wealth, precious gems, and even beauty. In today's Gospel passage, a young man approaches Jesus and asks, "*Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?*" Jesus referred him to God's commandments. The young man replied that he always observed them and had done many good deeds. Then, Jesus said, "*You lack one thing: go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven: then come, follow me.*" The young man could not part with his fortune and he walked away sadly.

To be truly free, we must be willing to embrace our faith and free ourselves from anything that could hold us back, even our own selves. We follow Jesus and place our trust in him. Some have made this passage into a parable on choosing a religious vocation, but this is only one interpretation. Jesus simply spoke about the interaction between our faith and circumstances. Money is very useful. We have to know how to manage it carefully, but it won't save our souls. We must be wise. Money is a precious servant but can become an evil and exacting master.
