Sharing what little she had

Despite the information overload that inundates us today, I am still inspired by learning about positive initiatives coming from under-privileged contexts. What immediately comes to mind are the socially conscious and effective community kitchens where people of modest means freely exchange food and recipes, with a zest of solidarity. The Gospel story of the widow's mite is a good example. This poor widow went to the Temple and deposited two small coins for the collection. Jesus praised her modest contribution as a model of generosity. She shared what she could. Christ did not see this as an insignificant gesture. He used it to teach the disciples about simple, heartfelt deeds that reveal one's soul. In Christ's eyes, what counted was not the magnitude of gift, but the donor's intention. What was Christ's message? The Lord preferred her discrete and humble offering to others made with ostentatious display. Christ remarked that those who court praise and honors have already received their reward. More information is available about the widow who donated her mite. She herself was in great need, yet despite her difficult situation, she still wanted to help others who were also in distress. Jesus remarked that the widow's gift came from her meager means. It was a small offering which she generously and courageously chose to share. We all experience difficulties, individually or as a group, whether they be personal, spiritual or financial. By choosing to dig deep into our resources, as limited as they may be, and alleviate the misery of others, we imitate this widow's actions which Christ recognized and praised. Small gestures of sharing and love are always signs of a generous heart. The Lord comes, with his blessings and generosity, to those who act in his name and care for people in need.
