Following the Call to the Priesthood or Consecrated Life –

Jesus calls every person to follow him, as the Catechism reminds us: "Although man can forget God or reject him, He never ceases to call every man to seek him, so as to find life and happiness" (#30). But he calls some people to serve him and his Church in a special way. He calls some men to the priesthood, and some men and women to the consecrated life. St John Bosco used to say that one in four was called to this life of prayer, sacrifice, and heroic service. Without a doubt, God is calling some of the young men and women in our parish family to this special vocation. He is asking them to leave behind their personal plans and trust exclusively in him - just as Peter and Andrew left behind their boat, their nets, and their business. He is asking them to leave behind the beautiful affections of family life and give their hearts entirely to him - just as John and James left their father Zebedee behind in the boat. These special vocations touch all of our lives; the Church cannot do without them; Christ yearns for them. And yet, they don't happen automatically. Christ doesn't force anyone to say yes to his invitation. If Christ is calling you, do not be afraid. Take the next step. Don't wait - the Gospel says that these first apostles left everything "immediately". Leave behind the nets, the boat, the affections - Jesus will never let you down; he is God; he deserves your trust. For the rest of us, as Jesus renews his total commitment to us in this Mass, let's promise him that we too will follow him more closely this week, being his courageous representatives in our corner of the world, thus helping others hear and heed his call in their lives.
