1) EMBS Priests' Pension Plan 2020

1 – Current Situation

The priests' pension plan annual collection will take place Sunday, November 1st, 2020. Last year's collection generated \$60,763.00. We are very appreciative of your concern for our welfare over the eight (8) years that we have had this collection. As the number of retired priests outnumber the active priests by a ratio of 2 to 1, it has made it difficult to increase the pension benefit. Continued low interest rates plus the fact that people are living longer have also delayed any increases. With your help, the monthly pension changed from \$750 to \$800 in 2014 and then to \$900 effective July 2020. With amalgamation taking place civilly likely next year, we are targeting to reach the level that Ottawa priests receive (\$1,125 per month) by having a further increase to \$1,000 as of January 2021. Through your generosity, we are hoping to be able to do so and thank you for your consideration. 2 – Comment from a retired priest

Dear members of our diocesan family:

I'm writing to you on the occasion of the annual collection in favor of the Pension Fund for the priests of our former Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall. Most of you know me quite well. I'm Monsignor Réjean Lebrun, a diocesan priest for 58 years, and I have been retired since 2014. I have now reached the "vulnerable" age of 83. I am sufficiently well to continue assisting in parish life. Since my retirement I live in a comfortable apartment but then I'm completely on my own financially speaking. I no longer enjoy the advantages of parish benefits. This is where the priests' pension fund comes in for assistance, one that I truly appreciate. Without this pension fund, I would find it challenging to have "ends meet". I wish to express my heartfelt gratitude to all of you for your generous response to our annual collection for the Priests' Pension Fund. Sincere thanks for the assistance that you provide to your elderly, retired clergy.

I know that the Lord who is infinitely generous with us all will reward you with an abundance of blessings and graces.
